

LICE AND SCABIES TREATMENTS

All products should be applied and removed exactly as directed. A nit comb must be used to physically remove head lice and nits after treatment.

PEDICULICIDES AND LICE REMOVAL PRODUCTS			
benzyl alcohol 5%	Ulesfia	Rx lotion	Treatment of head lice. Avoid contact with eyes. <6mos: Not recommended. ≥6mos: Apply sufficient amount to dry hair to completely saturate scalp and hair. After 10min, thoroughly rinse off with water. Repeat after 7 days. Wash hands after application.
ivermectin 0.5%	Sklice	Rx lotion	Treatment of head lice. Avoid contact with eyes. <6mos: Not recommended. ≥6mos: Apply sufficient amount (up to 1 tube) to thoroughly coat the hair and scalp. After 10min, thoroughly rinse off with water.
lindane 1%	Lindane Shampoo	Rx shampoo	Treatment of resistant head and pubic lice; not for prophylactic use or Norwegian (crusted) scabies. <i>Potential toxicities:</i> seizures, aplastic anemia, renal disorders. For single application only; do not reapply. Do not exceed maximum recommended doses. Wear gloves when applying; avoid other unnecessary exposure.
malathion 0.5%	Ovide	Rx lotion	Treatment of head lice. For use on scalp only. May repeat in 7–9 days, if needed. Product is flammable.
permethrin 1%	Nix	OTC cream rinse	Treatment of head lice. Repeat in 7 days if live lice are evident. Also for prophylaxis of head lice in institutional epidemics. <i>Caution:</i> chrysanthemum or ragweed allergy.
pyrethrins 0.3% + piperonyl butoxide 3%	R&C	OTC shampoo	Must repeat in 7–10 days. <i>Caution:</i> ragweed allergy.
pyrethrum extract 0.33% + piperonyl butoxide 4%	A-200 Pronto Plus Lice Killing Hair + Scalp Masque Pronto Plus Lice Killing Mousse Shampoo Pronto Plus Lice Killing Shampoo Pronto Plus Lice Killing Warm Oil Treatment + Conditioner	OTC shampoo OTC masque OTC mouse shampoo OTC shampoo OTC oil treatment/conditioner	Must repeat in 7–10 days. <i>Caution:</i> ragweed allergy.
pyrethrins 0.33% + piperonyl butoxide 4%	Rid Lice Killing Shampoo, Max STR Rid Lice Killing No-Drip Mousse	OTC shampoo OTC mousse	Must repeat in 7–10 days. <i>Caution:</i> ragweed allergy.
spinosad 0.9%	Natroba	Rx topical susp	Treatment of head lice. Avoid contact with eyes. <4ys: Not recommended. ≥4ys: Apply up to 120mL (one bottle) to dry scalp and hair until adequately covered. After 10min, thoroughly rinse off with warm water. May repeat after 7 days, if needed. Wash hands after application.
NIT REMOVAL AIDS			
bebanamidopropyl dimethylamine	Rid Egg & Nit Comb Out Gel	OTC gel	Only for use as adjunct to RID shampoo to remove nits, not for use alone. Must repeat in 7–10 days.
dimethicone 100%	Rid Pure Alternative	OTC gel	Apply gel to dry hair. After 10min, use provided comb to remove nits. Shampoo. Repeat as needed.
PEDICULICIDES, LICE, AND NIT REMOVAL PRODUCTS			
dimethicone	Licend	OTC gel	To eliminate lice, eggs and nits from head and body hair. Dye- and pesticide-free. Use provided comb to remove lice, eggs and nits. Shampoo with warm water. Inspect hair for 10 days. Repeat as needed.
crotamiton 10%	Eurax	Rx cream or emollient-base lotion	Reapply after 24hrs.
lindane 1%	Lindane Lotion	Rx lotion	Treatment of resistant scabies or in patients intolerant of other therapies; not for prophylactic use or Norwegian (crusted) scabies. <i>Potential toxicities:</i> seizures, aplastic anemia, renal disorders. For single application only; do not reapply. Do not exceed maximum recommended doses. Wear gloves when applying; avoid other unnecessary exposure.
permethrin 5%	Acticin Elimite	Rx cream Rx cream	One application is usually effective; may repeat in 14 days if living mites are still present. <i>Caution:</i> pyrethrins, pyrethroids, or chrysanthemum allergy.
