Treatment of head lice. Avoid contact with eyes. <6mos: Not recommended.

≥6mos: Apply sufficient amount to dry hair to completely saturate scalp and hair. After 10min, thoroughly rinse off with water. Repeat after 7 days. Wash hands after application.

≥6mos: Apply sufficient amount (up to 1 tube) to thoroughly coat the hair and scalp. After 10min, thoroughly rinse off with water.

Treatment of head, body and pubic lice. Not for lice in eyebrows or

≥2yrs: Apply thoroughly to dry hair or other affected area. After 10min, add water to form lather then rinse thoroughly; towel dry. Pubic lice: treat consorts also. Must repeat in 7–10 days.

≥6mos: Apply to dry scalp and hair until adequately covered; use up to 120mL (one bottle). Leave on for 10 mins, then rinse off thoroughly with warm water. May repeat after 7 days if needed.

To eliminate lice, eggs and nits from head and body hair. Dye- and pesticide-free. Use provided comb to remove lice, eggs and nits. Shampoo with warm water. Inspect hair for 10 days. Repeat as needed.

Treatment of resistant scabies or in patients intolerant of other therapies;

One application is usually effective; may repeat in 14 days if living mites
